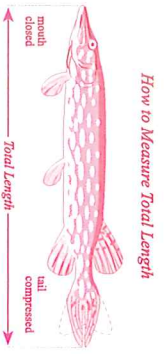

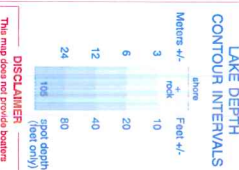

How to Measure Total Length
